We have grown many thousands deciduous and coniferous trees from bare root stock. Some are pretty easy to grow, some are not. Some take hold quickly and some take several years or more to really get going. Some deciduous varieties need to be "sweated-out" in order to "break bud" or they will die. This process can be very difficult for most people to do.

We sell a lot of bare root deciduous stock and will sometimes sell a few varieties of bare root conifers. Some varieties of deciduous and conifer plants have a very high mortality rate and we'll see as much as a 50% or more loss on them. Other varieties may have as much as a 95% to 100% success rate on some batches. One can expect some loss on most bare root plants.

Due to many varying factors we only sell bare root stock that has higher success rates for the general public.

Bare root stock is the least expensive way to purchase plants if you choose ones that are known to have a good success rate.
